TO: ALL UNITS RECEIVING UTILITY SERVICES

SUBJECT: COMMUNICATIONS

1/ IN THE INTEREST OF BETTER SERVICE AND FOR THE SAFETY OF FLYING PERSONNEL IT IS REQUESTED THAT THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURE BE OBSERVED:

- A. BEGIN GUARD ON BASE RADIO AND PLANE FREQUENCY FIFTEEN MINUTES PRIOR TO SCHEDULED TIME FOR PLANE TO ARRIVE ON STATION.
- B. ON SECURING PLANE CONTINUE GUARD UNTIL PLANES GIVES BASE RADIO "EASY CHARLIE ZEBRA", MEANING IT IS ENTERING CONTROL ZONE AND IS SHIFTING RECEIVER TO NORTH ISLAND TOWER FREQUENCY.

2/ DUE TO NUMBER OF PLANES CONDUCTING EXERCISES WITH DETACHED UNITS ON THE SAME FREQUENCY STRICT RADIO DISCIPLINE MUST BE MAINTAINED THIS FREQUENCY IS PRIMARILY TO GUARD SAFETY OF PLANE AND CREW.

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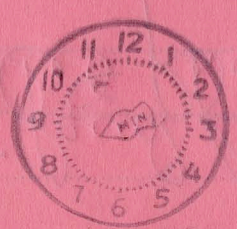



NOTES

Radar equipped ships will utilize every opportunity for training with radar, particularly as to determining its effectiveness and limitations, and to constantly exercise radar officers and operators while at sea, on every available target; land, air, and surface. When operating with submarines, radar equipped ships will conduct exhaustive tests to determine the limitations of their radar equipment on this type of craft as periscope depth, awash, and on the surface. Commanding Officers must take maximum use of daylight hours for conduct of training underway. In general, ships will not return to port until just prior to sunset. Commanding Officers will avail themselves of all opportunities for training in damage control, engineering instruction, exercises with radar, exchange of recognition signals, calibration of rangefinders and radar, torpedo control, tracking drills, signal drills, emergency drills, ship handling, boat handling, passing mail, and the many other detailed drills and exercises necessary to bring their ships to a complete state of readiness for action with all components of their armament. Ships firing torpedo practices as well as those acting as torpedo ships, will utilize this opportunity to familiarize all sound operators with the sound of torpedoes traveling through the water.

Tracking planes for torpedoes will take pictures.

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NOTES

1. Target Plan "Able" is location of target for torpedo planes (Lat. $32^{\circ}32'$ N., Long. $117^{\circ}16'$ W.) Ships may maneuver to avoid torpedoes.
2. Sound School area includes: 4627, 4628, 4629, 4630, 4727, 4728, 4729, 4730, 4827, 4828, 4829, 4830.
3. When vessels or aircraft are operating with Patrol Vessels their duties are paramount. In the event it is necessary to leave for special duty she will inform vessel or aircraft by best means available. If aircraft are desired to operate with her on a special mission, aircraft can be informed by calling "Tango" when operating with VC squadrons.
4. On simulated night torpedo attacks by planes, 1 pass is made over the ship for identification purposes.
5. Tugs, with towed target, to be informed when to resume standard speed while on base course at steerageway. Also to be informed as to base course and speed to be maintained; and upon completion of exercise to be notified so tug may slow down.
6. Ships operating with VC squadrons should guard 6630 at least five minutes before exercise for testing.
7. Anti-aircraft gun firing practice from the West Bluff of Fort Rosecrans is scheduled daily during the hours of 0900 to 1700. The boundaries of danger area over the ocean are as follows:
North boundary - Lat. $32^{\circ}47'$ N.; South boundary Lat. $32^{\circ}39'$ N. firing will cover a field of fire of 30° each side of the line due west from the firing point. Max. range 15,000 yards (offshore) max. ordinate 30,000 feet. The boundaries of the area for the airplane and the towed target, including the north and south turning points over the ocean are as follows: North boundary - Lat. $32^{\circ}46'$ N., South boundary Lat. $32^{\circ}38'$ N. Airplanes will fly offshore from 1,000 to 5,000 yards and at an altitude from 1,500 to 12,000 feet. Length of target tow line is 1,000 yards. Target will be dropped over Ft. Rosecrans.
8. There will be intermittent firing of 90mm guns and automatic weapons from the bluff west of Camp Callan daily except Sunday between 0800-1700 (Target Practice). Boundaries are as follows:
South boundary - Lat. $32^{\circ}52'$ N. (Scripps Pier)
North boundary - Lat. $33^{\circ}00'$ N. (Torrey Pines)
East boundary - Long. $117^{\circ}14'$ West.
West boundary - Long. $117^{\circ}26'$ West, max. ordinate 9,000 yds.
9. Border Field Danger area - Point of beginning: Lat. $32^{\circ}32'23''$ N. Long. $117^{\circ}06'46''$ W. Machine gun firing west in a 46° spread to Long. $117^{\circ}12'22''$ W. 0800 to 1630 Monday thru Friday. Tracer MG firing Friday from 1730 to 1930.
10. Pacific Beach AA Danger area - 3 inch, 50 cal., 20 and 40 mm firing 1000 to 1700 daily, and 2030 to 2230 at flare or illuminated sleeve. Boundaries: 290° True from Bird Rock to Long. $117^{\circ}29'30''$ West. 230° True from beach (Lat. $32^{\circ}48'$ N.) to Long. $117^{\circ}29'30''$ West, max. ordinate 36,000 feet.
11. Camp Pendleton AA or Surface firing daily 0800 to 1800. Danger area from south bank Santa Margarita River $234\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ for 9 nautical miles; thence $324\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ for $4\frac{1}{2}$ nautical miles; thence $054\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ to the beach, max. range 18,000 yards, max. ordinate 30,000 feet.
12. SOUND SCHOOL - Vessels of the Sound School are called "Sound School vessels". Vessels operating under COTC PAC with the Sound School are called "Guest Vessels" and will conform with Sound School schedules. Vessels visiting and under schedules of their own are called "Visiting vessels". Vessels should get underway at 0600 to be at rendezvous point with the Sound School group at 0800. These vessels will conform with COTC PAC's instructions. Vessels operating with Sound School guard 2590 Kcs., when not, use 2196. For those desiring additional sound training arrangements have been made for one of the Sound School vessels, towing repeater target, to be at sea daily 0730 until about 1700. She will operate on a line from point "Dog" (Lat. $32^{\circ}35'$ N., Long. $117^{\circ}18'$ W.) to Coronados Islands. Vessels proceeding to and from harbor wishing to make sound run using these facilities, contact tow vessel by visual and make arrangements.
13. Ships signal planes, when operating with them, by using "Peter". Planes acknowledge by "zooming". This will apply to all plane-ship operations.

COMMUNICATION PLAN

1. All vessels and aircraft use "Informal name" calls as shown on the informal name call sheet following, during operations in this schedule. Regular calls enciphered in CSP 1312 should be used for traffic to be relayed out of district. At all times when referring to frequencies, use 11ND FDS-1. If not held, obtain from PatCon Radio, Room 311, District Headquarters.
2. TABLE "A"-Maintain continuous watch on 2196 Kcs. while away from visual, wire or physical communications with Eleventh Naval District Hdqts. Ships operating with the West Coast Sound School will use 2590 Kcs. instead of 2196 Kcs., notifying NQG-3 by "Zebra" signal, and using Patcon Frequency Designator Chart. Loudspeaker watch may be maintained if desired. Either CW or Voice may be used. Vessels able to maintain listening watch on more than one frequency will guard 2196 Kcs. plus other frequency required for operations.
3. TABLE "B"-Blimps guard 2196 Kcs. and base frequency (3795 Kcs.) while away from Base. During special missions, guard 3000 Kcs. in lieu of 2196 Kcs. Call NQG-3 if unable to establish communications.
4. TABLE "C"-Planes guard 3865 Kcs. Voice during operations. Vessels required to work these planes will assume guard and work on 3865 Kcs. If necessary to secure 2196 Kcs. vessels will advise NQG-3. Plane frequencies guarded by MED from 0730 to 1800 each day. Vessels unable to operate on higher frequencies may relay via NQG-3 to MED.
5. TABLE "D"-Planes guard 6630 Kcs. YF torpedo pick-up boat will guard 6630 Kcs. as well as 2550 Kcs. during torpedo exercises. In the event of any difficulty arising for vessels acting as target for "Target Plan Able" to communicate with planes direct they can call UNCLE CHARLIE on 6630 Kcs. CW. UNCLE CHARLIE will then relay message to the plane. In the event UNCLE CHARLIE cannot be contacted on 6630 Kcs. contact WALT on 2196, who will then contact UNCLE CHARLIE by telephone. In case of failure of communication at "Target Plan Able" target vessel two-block "Baker" and head on a northerly course at best safe speed with boilers cut in at that time. Planes will then attack.
6. TABLE "E"-Distant patrol vessels guard 2550 Kcs. while operating.
7. TABLE "F"-Vessels attached to Task Unit 96.8.1 or operating with them, guarding 2550 Kcs. Circuit Control stations will call "Diego".
8. Air and surface craft engaged in common operations will guard and operate on 3000 Kcs. and surface craft will notify NQG-3 before securing either normal frequency or 3000 Kcs.
9. Broadcasts by NQG-3 on 2196 Kcs. as follows:
