Statement concerning age error on both Mont. N.G. and FMCR enlistment papers.

In 1926 or 1927, whichever year is shown, these papers not being in my possession, I enlisted in the Montana National Guard, 163rd Infantry, Headquarters Company, located at Helena, Montana, at the specific request of the late Captain Ferguson, my father's friend, and who was then in command.

Captain Ferguson informed me of my age, which was sixteen. In order to enlist I would have to have a consent paper from my parents. These I had recently left in Guam. Captain Ferguson put down my age as eighteen to save the four or five months it would have taken to have communicated with my parents - airmail not being in service at that time and transports very few. This practice was quite usual and the company was filled with young men out of High School.

I served only a few months in this company for I was recalled to the tropics by my parents.

In 1930 I enlisted in the Fleet Marine Corps Reserve, 20th Regiment, Company G and because my papers read in error and because no oath or birth certificate was involved, the error was perpetuated, whether correctly or not I cannot state.

I have an official age with the Navy, my correct age, which has been on record most of my life.

This error of age is regretted at this time even though it is very usual. I have the precedence of my own father, Lt.-Cmdr. H.R. Hubbard (SC) USN who, being five years younger than needful at the time of his entrance into the service, was officially five years older than the truth until sometime in the twenties when this was officially adjusted.

Dear Mr. Carter:

Capt. LaFayette Ronald Hubbard reported to this office on July 20, 1946 for routine physical examination. He gave history and showed documentary evidence from the U. S. Naval Hospital at Oakland, California, of being disabled on three counts: Intermittent lameness in the right hip due to bone infection, marked decrease in visual acuity, and duodenal ulcer confirmed by X-ray findings.

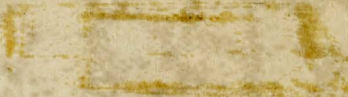
Physical examination at this time does not reveal any aggravation of his hip condition. Test of the visual acuity shows right eye uncorrected: 20/100, corrected: 20/70. Left eye uncorrected: 20/100, corrected: 20/50. Both eyes corrected: 20/50. With regard to the duodenal ulcer, he is still on medication and is unable to do any routine duties without interruption.

In view of these findings, it does not seem to us that a disability of 10% adequately expresses the amount of infirmity present and we feel that his rating should be markedly increased.

On examination at discharge the following defects were noted:

History duodenal Ulcer 1943- 1945

Eyes: Right 5/20 corrected to 12/20 by lens

Left 5/20 corrected to 14/20 by lens

Defects conjunctivitis chronic, mild, bilateral

Teeth 1, 16, 17, 32 missing

Spine and extremities: Pain on lateral rotation and abduction of right shoulder, right joint tender, hip joint tender duodenal ulcer.

On February 13, 1946 the Veterans Administration received 526 Claim for the following disabilities:

Duodenal ulcer; pains in side, headaches, eyes rheumatism (Reiters disease), left knee sprain; conjunctivitis, active; arthritis right hip and shoulder; malaria recurrent.

On February 13, 1946 the Veterans Administration assigned the following rating based on evidence of record at that time

10% from February 17, 1946 for duodenal ulcer

0% from February 17, 1946 for malaria

0% from February 17, 1947 for conjunctivitis VOD 12/20 VOS 14/20

NN sprain left knee; arthritis, right hip and shoulder

"BOARD NOTE"

Sporadic pain, left side, back, right shoulder, was shown on terminal examination. This condition was purely subjective and not a disease or injury within the meaning of the law.

On August 12, 1946, the Veterans Administration receive a letter from the Veteran expressing dissatisfaction with award, and his intention of Appealing the decision, also a medical statement from G. J. Walsh, M.D. (SEE EXHIBT "A")

On September 19, 1946, veteran was examined by the Veterans Administration at Los Angeles, at which time the following diagnosis was made:

Calcified brusitis sub deltoid

Hypertrophic Arthritis both ankels

Miminal duodenal deformity without ulcer crator formation

No Board action was taken on this examination as it was not complete.

On January 30, 1948 the veteran was again examined at Birmingham General Hospital, Van Nuys, California and the following diagnosis was made:

Arthritis, hypertrophic chronic, thoracic vertebra, cause undetermined

No disease of duodenal ulcer found at this time, although history is suggestive and old x-rays should be reviewed.

No disease of genitor-urinary system found

Astigmatism myopic and blepharoconjunctivitis, chronic

Right 20/60-left 20/70, corrected to 20/20 bilateral.

On February 12, 1947, the Rating Board assigned the following Rating based on the two Veterans Administration examinations and letter from Dr. Walsh:

- 7305 10% from February 17, 1946 for duodenal ulcer
 - 5019 10% from February 17, 1946 for brusitis, calcified, right shoulder
 - 5003 10% from February 17, 1946 to December 10, 1947
20% from December 12, 1947 for arthritis, hypertrophic multiple joints, right hip, dorsel spine and ankles with recurrent dorsal myositis
 - 6018 10% from February 11, 1947 for blepharo-conjunctivitis, chronid bilateral
0% from February 17, 1947 for malaria
Sprain, left knee not shown by evidence of record
- Combined
30% from February 17, 1947 to December 10, 1947
40% from December 12, 1947

"Board Remarks" Rating of February 13, 1946, is amended and suspended to allow service connection and compensable rating for infection of eyes, brusitis, right shoulder, and arthritis multiple joints all of which conditions were noted in service, and shown to be present by Veterans Administration examination of September 19, 1946 and February 12, 1947, which demonstrate increased back disability not previously shown

Trusting this review will be of help to you in representing the veteran's claim before the Navy Review Board.

1. A statement regarding reference (a) is respectfully submitted.


2. Any explanation of action referred to in reference (a) is contained in reference (b), to wit: first, the existence of tacit permission to conduct non-scheduled firing; second, the appearance the area bore to a firing area; third, the absence of orders regarding such actions; fourth, the establishment of the fact that other naval vessels had previously so anchored without thought of reprimand.

3. Regarding reference (c) I have the deepest respect for orders.

4. The condition of my ship played no part in my loss of command. My relief had nothing but praise for her condition, materiel and personnel. My men cooperated eagerly in creating a good ship and, as any of my crew would testify, were intensely loyal to me. Since my detachment I have received individual requests from nearly all my former crew to be asked for and allowed to serve under me again.

5. That I was ill with a streptococci throat and dull from sulphathiazole on the date of the incident in reference (b), (subsequently spending three months in the hospital under treatment), in no way mitigates the seriousness of the offense, but may serve to explain in part an apparent lapse of judgment.

6. It is my hope that the future may add to my record, evidence of my sincerity in wishing to serve well my service and my country.
