This request is made pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552.

Please send me any and all files possessed by the Personnel Records Center that pertain in any fashion to former Lt. LaFayette Ronald Hubbard of the U.S. Naval Reserve. Hubbard was born on March 13, 1911, and died in January of this year. A copy of his death certificate is attached. Hubbard entered naval service in July 1941 and was discharged in October 1950.

Hubbard's death, of course, makes accessible records that have previously been withheld as confidential under the FOI and privacy acts. The privacy rights of Hubbard's surviving relatives must be considered in the narrowest of terms and cannot be used as an excuse to provide only the barest details of Hubbard's military service. Remember, the applicable statutes require that you adopt a view favoring the broadest possible public disclosure.

Moreover, should you withhold any documents, you must cite the precise statutory exemption for your refusal. As you know, the law requires also that "any segregable portion of a record shall be provided...after deletion of the portions which are exempt by law." Please be advised that, if necessary, the Los Angeles Times is prepared to pursue all available legal avenues to obtain the records herein sought. If you refuse to disclose certain documents, and a court overturns your decision, the court is empowered to award the person seeking the documents attorney fees and court costs.

My request includes, but is not limited to, Hubbard's military personnel records, his medical personnel records, a list of all medals he was authorized to wear at the close of World War II and all official inquiries and correspondence pertaining to Hubbard's military performance. This would include his "reports on the fitness of officers" and the report of a naval board of investigation concerning the firing of shots near the Mexican coast by a vessel under Hubbard's command. I believe this report was dated Dec. 1943.

Please also send all documents concerning Hubbard's removal from command positions as a result of possibly being unfit. In addition, it is imperative that you provide documentation that would either support or refute contentions that the Navy maintained at least two seperate and different personnel files on Hubbard, one being a cover for his intelligence work. I ask that you also either confirm or deny an assertion by Hubbard that his naval records state: "This officer has no neurotic or psychotic tendencies whatsoever."

I additionally request all records regarding Hubbard's involvement in a naval investigation of John Whiteside Parsons, a rocket fuels expert, or whether such an investigation was ever undertaken during the mid 1940s.

I understand that you probably have a backlog of requests. However, the requested information is of a timely nature for a newspaper article and I would be grateful for any help you could provide in expediting this matter. On Aug. 6, I mailed a similiar request to the director of the National Personnel Records Center, which apparently was lost. Understandably, those things happen, but it has made a prompt response to this request all the more important.

Thank you for your assistance. I promise to pay reasonable setach and duplication fees in connection with this request. Please bill the Los Angeles Times, Times Mirror Square, Los Angeles, Ca. 90053. I look forward to receiving your reply within 10 business days, as required by law.

- 1. Reference (a) is forwarded as a matter under your cognizance. The major difficulty that this officer has with the Hubbard case is that we do not have copies of the letters sent out in the past in reply to the numerous FOIA requests which have been done. It is very difficult for us to respond to this type of request when those papers are not filed down in the record.
- 2. The second area of difficulty revolves around Mr Hubbard's Naval Medical Record. Our records indicate that this is a combined record (meaning that both the Personnel and the Medical Records are stored together) and that Mr Hubbard's Naval Medical Record was most probably forwarded to Brian Robertson on the 25th of July 1986, but it was not noted on our control card. We know that when the record was returned to this office only the Personnel Record was returned and the Medical Record was not there. Could Brian have sent the Naval Medical Record to the Naval Medical Command for a response? This we do not know. Have looked in all locations where Mr Hubbard's Naval Medical Record could be stored out here and it is not here.
- 3. Finally, the statement that "dead people don't have no privacy" is a difficult one for us to clarify out here into a working procedure. If you could provide further direction here, it would be most helpful.
- 4. Call if there are any questions on the above, or if you find Mr Hubbard's Naval Medical Record. As you can see by my response to Mr Sappell, I am still on the hook for that Medical response.

I am writing to request your assistance in obtaining the military records of L. Ron Hubbard (aka Lafayette Ronald Hubbard; b. 1911; d. 1986). His name may be familiar to you as the founder of Scientology and Dianetics.

Many claims are made about his background. Specifically, that he served as a "commander of corvettes" and that between May 18-21, while commanding the PC185, he sunk a Japanese submarine off the Oregon coast near Cape Lookout.

In May of last year I wrote to the Bureau of Naval Personnel at the Arlington Annex. In August, I received a reply from the National Personnel Records Center in St. Louis. This letter stated that they did not have the records, which had been loaned to the Bureau of Naval Personnel in Washington, and suggested that I either contact them (BNP) directly or contact teh NPRC in a few months.

I have written to both offices and have not received any reply from them.

Given your involvement in national defense matters, there is no doubt in my mind that must understand the need for factual representation of a military history, especially when it is used as part of the "advertising" for Dianetics and Scientology. In addition to various claims (as I have stated above), Scientology also distributes a document called the "Prouty Affidavit"; in this document, Colonel

L. Fletcher Prouty claims that Hubbard's records were altered to conceal his performance of intelligence duties.

In any case, it would be interesting and useful to know what the truth is, and to know it once and for all. I cannot help but think that an inquiry from your office to whatever agency holds Mr. Hubbard's file (which should be readily available to the public) will produce the desired results.

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



Dear Sir,

I have recently obtained a purported Notice of Separation record which I believe to be a forgery, as it differs considerably from that provided by the Bureau of Naval Personnel through FOIA. It lists World War II awards ("Br. & Dtch. Vict. Meds.") and other qualifications which simply do not exist. It is being represented as a true and accurate record originating with the Bureau (and your copy is claimed to be a forgery manufactured by the US Navy). I enclose a copy of the disputed record for your interest.

I am trying to corroborate certain other details given in the purported record, in particular the following points:

- 1. The record refers to USS Howland. I can find no record of this in the Dictionary of American Fighting Ships, but I believe it may have been the name given to a naval receiving station on Long Island, NY during World War 2. Can you confirm this?
- 2. The record lists Lt L. R. Hubbard USNR 113392 as being the Commanding Officer of the *USS Howland*, though the period is not given. Do you have a record of the *Howland's* COs during the period 1 July 1941 through 31 December 1945?
- 3. The record purports to have been signed by Lt Cdr Howard D. Thompson USNR, presumably on or around the date given on the document, 6 December 1945. Presumably Lt Cdr Thompson would have been assigned to the Bureau of Naval Personnel, given the supposed provenance of the record in question. Can you confirm his existence, did he serve in the Bureau in Nov-Dec 1945 and can you give me any details of his service record?

I would be grateful if you could action these requests under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act. I am willing to pay fees up to the value of \$60.

Dear Dr. Nienhuys:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act request, dated April 17, 2000, directed to Willie J. Bostick, Chief, Navy Reference Branch. Mr. Bostick is no longer assigned to the National Personnel Records Center, and your request has been referred to me for response. In reply to your questions, I can supply the following information:

1. We cannot supply you with a complete copy of the NAVPERS 553, Notice of Separation from the U.S. Naval Service, issued to Lafayette Ronald Hubbard on February 16, 1946. The National Personnel Records Center is the physical custodian of the military personnel records in our holdings, but legal custody remains with the individual military service departments that retire the records to us. What this means is that, in response to a third-party request such as yours, we are only allowed to release certain items of information from the records. We are not allowed to release complete or undeleted copies of documents, however, without the authorization of the veteran, or the veteran's next-of-kin. We suggest, therefore, that you contact the office listed below for a response to that portion of your request relating to a complete copy of the NAVPERS 553:

Bureau of Naval Personnel Liaison Office, Room 5409 9700 Page Avenue St. Louis, MO 63132-5100

2. We could find no document, a NAVPERS 553 or equivalent, issued to Mr. Hubbard at the end of the two-week period of Active Duty which he served from September 22, 1941, to October 6, 1941. We have, however, supplied a copy of a document from Mr. Hubbard's record indicating official notice of this period of duty.

- 3. We have been unable to identify a Howard D. Thompson who served as an officer in 1945 at the U.S. Naval Separation Center in San Francisco, California. We have reviewed the Register of Commissioned and Warrant Officers of the United States Naval Reserve for 1944. There was no Howard D. Thompson listed. We have no Register for the year of 1945, but we did check two other sources, including a microfilm listing of all Naval Officers. We found no evidence of a Howard D. Thompson who served as an officer in 1945.
- 4. We have also reviewed the Register of the Commissioned and Warrant
 Officers of the United States Navy and Marine Corps for the years of 1911 and
 1923. There was no Howard D. Thompson listed in these publications.

I hope that the information we have provided will be of assistance to you.



Dear Sir.

I have been shown an electronic copy of the Notice of Separation of Lafayette Ronald Hubbard, born 13 March 1911, serial number 113392.

This copy shows only sections 16 through 44 of the Notice of Separation. Section 17 mentions as date of entry into active service: 24 November 1941. In section 35 it shows the name and signature of J.C. Rhodes, and under section 34 the social security number 568-09-9422.

However, neither the name nor the signature of the individual concerned is mentioned, and also the date of the document (section 47) is missing in the copy shown to me.

I have been shown by followers of the late L.R. Hubbard a Notice of Separation that seems to be entirely bogus. For example it is signed by a 'Lt. Cmdr. USNR Howard D. Thompson', and I have been given to understand (not by aforementioned followers of course) that no such person existed, let alone that he was attached to the Officer Separation Center in San Francisco. However there seems to have been a Thompson active in the US Navy, nicknamed 'Snake' Thompson and possibly attached to the Medical Corps, who was gathering intelligence in Japan around 1911. Hubbard claims to have met this person around 1923.

Another point of divergence of the suspected bogus Notice with the real Notice is that the bogus Notice mentions in section 17 22 Sept. 41 rather than 24 November 1941.

Now the service record of the individual (which I received earlier through an appeal on the FOIA) says that there were two periods of active duty, one 22 SEP 41-06 OCT 41, and the next one 24 NOV 41-16 FEB 46. The individual was in the Officer Separation Center, San Francisco, on 05 DEC 45-06 DEC 45 according to his service record.

The above may serve as a motivation for my requests, appealing to the Freedom of Information Act:

- 1. May I have a copy of the entire Notice of Separation, showing sections 1 through 48?
- 2. Is there any document that was issued to L.R. Hubbard at the end of his first period of active service, i.e. around October 6, 1941, ascertaining the end of his active duty, and if so, may I receive a copy of that document?
- 3. Can you provide me with an authorative answer to the question of whether a Howard D. Thompson was in the U.S. Navy around 1945 and if so, was he attached to the Officer

Separation Center of San Francisco?

4. Do you have any record of a navy officer Thompson who was on an intelligence mission in Japan around 1911? His full name, rank and birth year would suffice, but any more information would be welcome, such as: was he in the Medical Corps and/or was he in 1923 in Washington.
